This funding will be used to

- Increase communication, literacy, engagement and learning outcomes for students using data from each student's learning plan – Learning Goals for a Queensland Certificate of Individual Achievement (QCIA), Individual Curriculum Plan (ICP), Planning Alternative Tomorrows with Hope (PATH), Senior Education and Training (SET) Plan and tracking the distance travelled during the school year.
- Align and enhance the Master Teacher's, Speech Language Pathologists' and Head of Curriculum's coaching in communication and literacy.
- Increase staff capacity through professional development and mentoring as documented in the Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) to improve each student's performance.
- Ensure students are attaining a QCIA and other certifications as documented in the AIP.

Our initiatives include

- Review each students' performance, engagement and attainment based on data collected, recorded and analysed in the targeted areas as part of an action research cycle designed to improve learning. Use recurring data cycles to monitor and adjust learning programs.
- Align specific teaching and learning pedagogies to improve student outcomes as documented in the AIP.
- Support the development of collaborative inquiry processes to build teacher capability in identifying, sharing and implementing effective communication and literacy teaching practices.
- Improve staff data literacy and use of OneSchool data to inform planning through mentoring by the Head of Curriculum.
- Improve teacher capability to collaboratively moderate the assessment of learning with units of work that are shared by multiple classes.
